## Co-counsel in \$80 million international arbitration

## First competition appeal on abuse of dominance

This was the first case in Singapore involving abuse of dominance, and resulted in a landmark decision by the Competition Appeal Board (SISTIC.com Pte Ltd v CCS [1/2010]).

## Representing a director sued for breach of fiduciary duties
